

- 46" W 36' L
- 1. Enlarge Pattern by inserting 9" length as shown.
- Cut 1 lining and
 1 outside piece
 (pastels only, please)
- With right sides together, stitch, using 1/4" seams. Leave side opening where indicated on pattern
- 4. Turn and Press.
- 5. Sew velcro where indicated (Note: INSIDE on flap, and OUTSIDE on envelope)
 Hint to sew HOOKED side of Velcro. Lay a piece of wax or tissue paper over hooks and they will not catch your thread when you sew..)
- Fold Bottom edge up to fold line indicated at base of flap.

 Pin to hold in place.
- if you can. If not, then 1/4" is fine, too. By topstitching the edge, the turning opening will automatically be sewn shut
- . DONE! Let's do some more!!

TWO YARDS of 45" Material
(One outside fabric
& One lining)
will yield 18 IV Envelopes!
