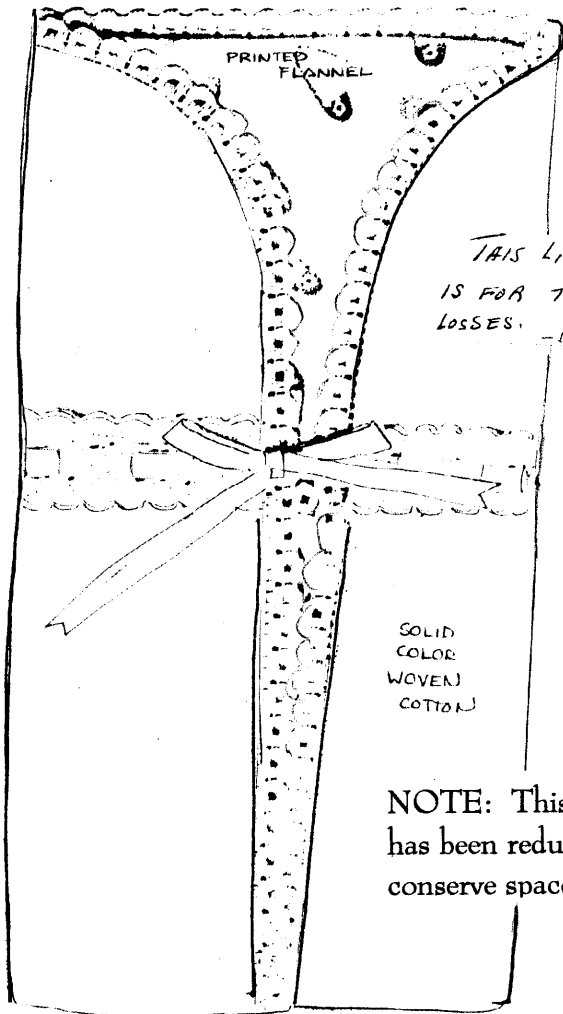


LITTLE SHROUD FOR THE SMALLEST LOSSES



THIS LITTLE SHROUD
IS FOR THE SMALLEST

SOLID
COLOR
WOVEN
COTTON

NOTE: This illustration

FLAP 3" WIDE x 5" LONG
CUT 2 - 1-IN COTTON AND
1-IN FLANNEL.

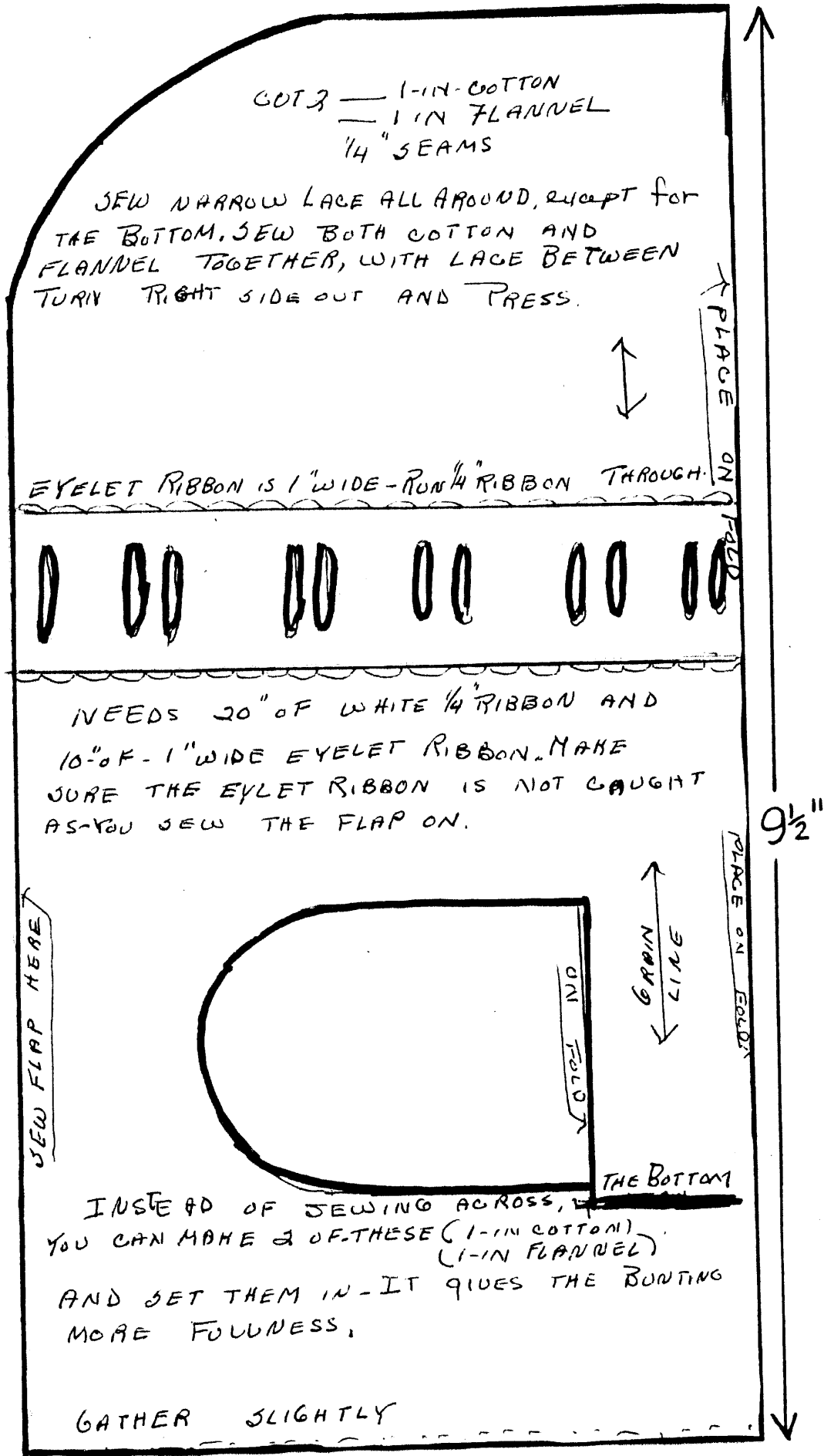
SEW LACE ACROSS TOP,
AND SEW DOWN SIDE SEAMS
TURN OUT AND PRESS.

SEW THIS FLAP ON
THE ^{RIGHT OR} LEFT SIDE OF THE
BUNTING, CLOSE TO THE
LACE TRIM. DO NOT
CATCH THE EYLET RIBBON
AS YOU SEW THE FLAP
DOWN ONE SIDE.

SEW ACROSS THE
BOTTOM OF THE BUNTING
CATCHING THE BOTTOM OF
THE FLAP. CLIP VERY CLOSE
AND ZIG ZAG ACROSS TO
NEATEN. TURN OUT AND PRESS

GRAIN LINE

SMALL BUNTING SHROUD
